











Protocol 55 TZEBAOT, Lord of Hosts

"For from the rising of the sun, even to its setting, My name shall be great among the nations. In every place incense is going to be offered to My name, and a grain offering that is pure; for My name shall be great among the nations," says the Lord of hosts. For I am a great King," says the Lord of hosts, "and My name is to be [reverently and greatly] feared among the nations." Malachi 1:11, 14b AMP

Wage war within me. Though the seas roar, You are the Lord of all that exists. You calm the wind and the stormy waves, making my heart still. I trust in You, Lord of Hosts.















Instructions:

- I. Pray 3 minutes in spontaneous worship, sing a spiritual song with a grateful heart. Suggested background worship: https://youtu.be/B6Zp5Jq_fkQ
- II. Repent of your sins. (Continue with background worship while we ask for forgiveness, partaking of the Lord's Supper).

- IV. Let us pray for the people of Israel, that each one, will hear Your VOICE O God, from the depths of their being, revealing to them, Who is their Messiah. We ask that through Him, they may receive Your guidance and protection as You open their hearts. Teach them that through the works of Your Son, on earth Your glory shines forth.

Take a minute to pray for Israel, for the peace of Jerusalem.

V. Let us adore, let worship never cease, let the fire on the Altar always be kept alive 24/7, to the ends of the earth. Let us ask that our hearts remain tender to Him in worship, understanding that this changes the atmosphere, Heaven opens and His Kingdom manifests.




