GLORY TO GOD IN THE HIGHEST

“Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among men with whom He is pleased.”

Luke 2:14 NASB

Lord, when You created the heavens, You established an eternal testimony of Your power and majesty. “The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky displays the work of His hands” (Psalm 19:1). Every shining star, every cloud crossing the sky, and every sunrise that illuminates the seas and the earth proclaim that You are the Sovereign Creator seated on Your Throne.

On Mount Sinai, Your majestic glory descended in the form of a cloud, and the people trembled as they beheld the magnificence of Your holiness. The prophet Ezekiel saw a vision of the glory of the Lord shining in a rainbow within the clouds, as an everlasting covenant with Your creation. (Ezekiel 1:28)

The perfect expression of Your glory is most profoundly reflected in the sacrifice of the Cross, when our Lord Jesus Christ gave His life to reconcile us to You (Hebrews 1:3). Through Him, we can now draw near to behold and partake of Your eternal glory.

Today we proclaim that Your glory fills not only the heavens but also the earth. You promised that “the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea.” (Habakkuk 2:14)

“The city has no need of the sun or the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God illuminates it, and the Lamb is its lamp.” (Revelation 21:23)





INSTRUCTIONS:

I. Pray 3 minutes in spontaneous worship, sing a spiritual song with a grateful heart. Suggested background worship:

II. Repent of your sins. (Continue with background worship while we ask for forgiveness, partaking of the Lord's Supper).

Let us ask that our hearts remain tender to Him in worship, understanding that this changes the atmosphere, Heaven opens and His Kingdom manifests.

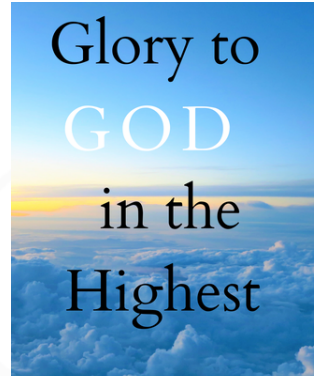
