Lion of Judah, You roar to unite us!

English

Instructions:

I. Pray 3 minutes in spontaneous worship, sing a spiritual song with a grateful heart. Suggested background music:

II. Repent of your sins. (Continue with background worship while we ask for forgiveness, partaking of the Lord's Supper).

a. I pray to the Lord our God and confess to Him:

"O Lord, You are a great and awesome God! You always keep Your covenants and Your promises of unfailing love with those who love You and obey Your commands; but I have sinned and done wrong. I have rebelled against You and despised Your commands and ordinances, especially that of uniting with my fellow born-again Christians. I have refused to listen to Your servants, the prophets, who spoke under Your authority to me and my ancestors. Lord, You are right; but as You see, my face is covered with shame. This happens to me because of my disloyalty to You.



O Lord, I am covered with shame, because I have sinned against You. But the LORD our God is merciful and forgiving, even though I have rebelled against Him. I have not obeyed the LORD our God, because I have not followed the instructions He gave me through His servants, the prophets. I X (mention your name) have disobeyed Your instructions, I have turned my back on You and refused to listen to Your voice. So now, because of my sin, I want to ask You not to allow any curse to come upon me. You always keep Your word, but I come to ask for mercy LORD, because I recognize Your truth and I want to forsake my sins. You have provided me with everything, through Your roar, through Your Word, You have displayed Your power, in view of Your faithful mercies. Please, Lord, turn away Your anger and wrath for my sins and the sins of my ancestors. O God, hear the prayer of Your servant! Hear, as I make my supplications to You. For Thy name's sake, O Lord, fill with Thy presence this desolate tabernacle of mine. O my God, bow down and hear me. Open Your eyes and look upon my despair. This I pray, not because I deserve Your help, but because of Your mercy. O Lord, hear me. O Lord, forgive me, O Lord, hear me and act. For Thy Name's sake, delay not, O my God, for I bear Thy Name.

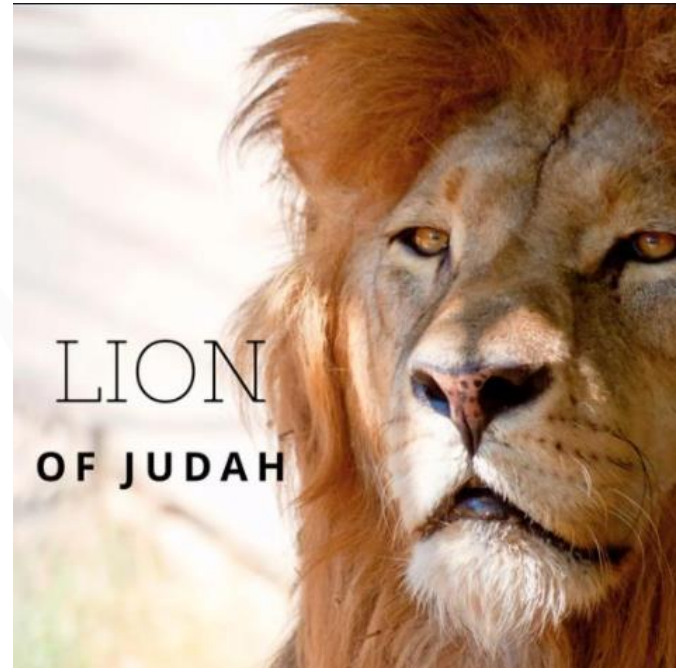

Supplement:

Lion of Judah roars to unite His Children

The Lion is already roaring with urgency to congregate His Children, to unite us, so that we love one another as He loves us, so that we respect our differences and are all of the same mind, that conviction that the Holy Spirit gives us. Now we have to do our part to unite with one another. That can only be achieved by being at peace with all our brethren and for that, we have to do a self-analysis and resolve any situation in our heart contrary to the Word of God.

“But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not be arrogant, and [as a result] be in defiance of the truth. This [superficial] wisdom is not that which comes down from above, but is earthly (secular), natural (unspiritual), even demonic. For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder [unrest, rebellion] and every evil thing and morally degrading practice.”

James 3:14-16 AMP

The consequences of having open doors to sin by having bitter envy and selfish ambitions in the heart can be:

Evil of all kinds, even extreme evil, confusion, lack of unity, immorality, morally degrading practices, rebellion, division, chaos and everything evil that exists, can manifest. The consequences fall upon the families of those who are in sin, upon their churches, their ministries, their cities and their nations. Practicing these sins gives legal right to all kinds of evil, so that spirits of immorality and perversion can enter.



The following questions are designed to make an examination of conscience before the Lord, to repent of having caused any kind of division, especially in the Body of Jesus Christ.

Ask yourself:

- Have I competed to have what another minister does or has?
- Have I given credit where credit is due?
- Have I boycotted someone else's participation in church activities?
- Have I influenced others to overshadow the name of another person or ministry?
- Have I sided with people who hinder another person?
- Have I prayed against a person or ministry?
- Have I followed the life of someone I want to affect step by step, in order to see at what point I could bring them down?
- Have I sought to have the same contacts as the person I want to usurp?
- Have I not been direct or sincere?
- Have I influenced them to remove the person I am jealous of from their activities?
- Have I cursed the children and murmured against the person I envy?
- Have I tried to take away the authority of the person I envy?
- Have I caused division?
- Have I murmured against, criticized, or judged other ministries, denominations, groups, or congregations?



Let us examine ourselves if we have fallen into these sins:

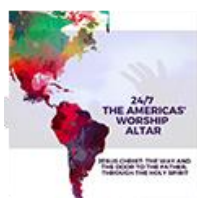
